Professional Development Credit

Credit Process

To ensure you can receive credit for your participation, please follow the following steps:

1. At each workshop you attend, collect a Certificate of Completion. This should list the workshop title, provider, date, hours of instruction, and your name.
2. Download and fill out the Credit Tracking Sheet. Use the "Workshops Completed" section to add up your hours. 1 credit will be given for every 10 hours, up to 4 credits per term.
3. When nearing completion of your total hours, email a copy of your preliminary Credit Tracking Sheet to the STEM Hub at: stem@hdsd.org. Please allow a minimum of 10 business days before the OSU registration deadline for CO STEM Hub to process.
4. Upon verifying the eligibility of the workshops you are including, the STEM Hub will email you a "Topics in STEM" OSU-Cascades Non-Admit application.
5. Complete the application and return to the OSU-Cascades Enrollment Services office at 500 SW Chandler Ave. Bend, OR 97702. A \$35 non-refundable application fee is required at this time. Depending on timing, you may need to enroll for the next academic term.

Eligible Workshops

Workshops that **may be** taken for credit include:

1. All teacher professional development workshops offered directly by the Central Oregon STEM Hub
2. Teacher professional development workshops offered by the Central Oregon STEM Hub partners when:

1. Workshop content is primarily related to STEM topics.
2. Partner offers a suitable certificate of completion to verify participation.

Eligible workshops will typically be listed in the STEM Hub calendar as "credit eligible" or similar. Any questions of workshop eligibility should be addressed to: stem@hdsd.org

Credit Process (continued)

6. Upon processing your applications, an OSU-Cascades Enrollment Services staff member will email instructions to register online for the appropriate course and pay your tuition of \$50 per credit. "Topics in STEM" is a variable unit course-be sure to register for the correct number of credits.
7. Upon finishing all workshops, complete the brief Reflection Piece described on the back of the Credit Tracking Sheet.
8. You must return to the STEM Hub for final review:

1. Your final Credit Tracking Sheet
2. Copies of all Certificates of Completion
3. Reflection Piece

9. The STEM Hub will verify your completion of all requirements to OSU-Cascades for final assignment of credit at the end of the academic week.
